- Demonstrate knowledge of people who settled in North America

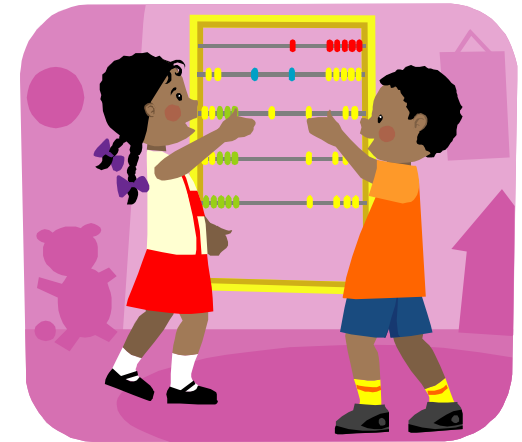

Language Arts:

The student will:

- Follow left to right progression
- Speak in complete sentences
- Write a sentence about a drawing
- Print uppercase/lowercase letters
- Recognize 26 uppercase/lowercase letters
- Associate 26 letters with their appropriate sound including long and short vowels
- Will learn 30 commonly used words by sight
- Experience different text through poems, rhymes, and songs
- Recognize and produce rhyming words
- Blend and segment words
- Read high-frequency words by sight

Personal:

The student will:

- Print his/her first/last name
- Know his/her birthday/phone number
- Be responsible for their own personal belongings

Math:

The student will:

- Demonstrate and understand a pattern
- Put objects together (Addition)
- Take objects away (Subtraction)
