

What Data Will I See On The Portal?

The data you will see in the Campus Portal is exactly what you would find on our Campus Student Information System. Each area of data is updated on different schedules. Please read the following to familiarize yourself with the Campus Portal data expectations.

FAMILY LINK

Allows you to preview your family demographic information.

CALENDAR

Shows a calendar and icons on the days there are assignments due or an attendance event occurred.

ATTENDANCE DATA

High School: Absence recorded every period. Excuse coded later in the day.

Middle School: Absence recorded every morning. Excuse coded later in the day.

Elementary: Absence recorded every morning. Excuse coded later in the day.

BEHAVIOR DATA

Shows the incident without specific details. Call the school's office for specific details about an incident.

CLASS SCHEDULE

Shows all courses the student will take during the current school year.

You can check assignments and email the teacher from this screen. Click on the title of the class to get to the grade book to see your students scores and grade. Teachers are expected to respond to parent emails within 3 school days.

CLASS ASSIGNMENTS

Class assignments and scores can be viewed through the Campus Portal once teachers have posted them in Campus Gradebook. Assignment posting to Campus Gradebook is mandatory at Maple River High School and Middle School. Maple River Elementary Schools will be posting items in the Campus Gradebook for grades 3-5. You may find some assignment data at the elementary level if teachers use Campus Gradebook.

Class assignments returned by their due date will be graded and the score posted by the 15th or 30th of the month unless otherwise noted by the teacher.

The correcting and posting of daily work will take precedence over the correct and posting of late assignments, i.e. if your child's work has been turned in late, don't expect to see scores immediately. Teachers may be responsible for evaluating over 100 students during a term/trimester. Careful and responsible evaluation of student work takes time.

Student scores are an approximate grade at a specific point in time and teachers reserve the right to modify grades based on their professional judgment at any time.

Additional information about a teachers expectations for the frequency and number of assignments in each class may be found by contacting the teacher personally either through email (the envelope icon on the Assignment screen) or by phone.

REPORTS

Student schedules, unofficial transcripts, and report cards can be printed from the Campus Portal.

Student Schedule

The student's schedule is always available to print.

Report Cards

Report cards can be printed approximately two weeks after the end of a term/trimester. Students are allowed this time to makeup any incompletes or failures.

Unofficial Transcript

Unofficial transcripts can be printed so you can verify the data recorded on your child's transcript. Data is rolled to the student's transcript approximately two weeks after the end of a term/trimester.

Official Transcripts must still be requested from the Guidance Office.

ACCOUNT #XXXX

Shows detailed information regarding your student's lunch account. Deposits, transactions and current balance can be viewed. Please contact the Food Service Department directly with questions or concerns regarding your child's lunch account information.

HEALTH IMMUNIZATIONS

Shows student immunizations.

ASSESSMENT

Shows student test scores for local, state and national tests.
